TRIAD Information

TRIAD provides faculty, classified staff, and community members with the opportunity to gather over lunch for networking and to learn more about research, teaching, and service at OSU and beyond. The three values of TRIAD are: Service, Cooperation and Fellowship.

Membership in TRIAD is open to all OSU faculty, staff, and community members. Every TRIAD lunch gathering is enlivened by individuals from many disciplines who have insights from diverse perspectives. All participants have a common bond to OSU, and share an interest in knowing individuals outside their usual work settings.

Endowed Scholarships: TRIAD members have endowed a scholarship that is awarded annually to one or more deserving OSU students who demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and service to the community. The scholarship recipients are honored at a TRIAD meeting in the spring term.

Participation & Membership: All are welcome to attend weekly TRIAD meetings. Members receive advance notice of upcoming TRIAD events, automatic lunch reservations, and reduced meal charges. Annual dues are \$35 for the first year, and \$70 for subsequent years. Meal charges are \$12 for active TRIAD members and their guests, \$13 for inactive TRIAD members and their guests or walk-in visitors.
